Judges representing NCSFA will evaluate the nominees on the basis of the established judging criteria. These criteria are designed to qualify the achievements and contributions of the nominees. Judges will be asked to assign a value of 1 to 10 to each of the following statements.

The nominee must be an NCSFA member in good standing and illustrates good character consistent with ethical business practices

The following criteria will be used to evaluate nominations:

- Significant advancement of the use or development of one or both of the following:
 - alternative vehicular fuels, vehicles or infrastructure, or;
 - electric or hybrid-electric vehicles or charging infrastructure
- Unique, innovative or creative in approach to deploy technologies listed above
- Has established and achieved specific, measurable results
- Has demonstrated the advancement of EPACT and DOE goals of improving air quality and reducing dependence on foreign oil
